

CSC 70010 – Analysis of Algorithms

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Note: This is only a guide, percentages and rules may change during the semester.

Final grade will be composed of the following components:

- * $\approx 40\% - 60\%$ final exam.

 - (ii) at the end of the class to check what you learned during the class.

- * You get 20% of the value if you leave the answer blank and no points for a wrong answer.

- * You **must** understand everything you write.
