

A Short Biography

Amotz Bar-Noy received a B.Sc. degree in Mathematics and Computer Science in 1981 and a Ph.D. degree in Computer Science in 1987, both from the Hebrew University, Israel. From October 1987 to September 1989 he was a post-doc fellow in the Computer Science Department at Stanford University, California. From October 1989 to August 1996 he was a Research Staff Member of the Communication and Networking Department at IBM T. J. Watson Research Center, New York. From February 1995 to September 2001 he was an Associate Professor in the Electrical Engineering - Systems department of Tel Aviv University, Israel. From September 1999 to December 2001 he was a Principal Technical Staff Member of the Internet and Networking Systems Research Center at AT&T research labs, New Jersey. Since February 2002 he is a Professor in the Computer and Information Science Department at Brooklyn College and in the Computer Science Department at the Graduate Center of CUNY, New York.
