For the following exercises, use the Hotel schema defined below:

Hotel (hotelNo, hotelName, city) Room (roomNo, hotelNo, type, price) Booking (hotelNo, guestNo, dateFrom, dateTo, roomNo) Guest (guestNo, guestName, guestAddress)

where

Hotel contains hotel details and hotelNo is the primary key; Room contains room details for each hotel and (roomNo, hotelNo) forms the primary key; Booking contains details of bookings and (hotelNo, guestNo, dateFrom) forms the primary key; Guest contains guest details and guestNo is the primary key.

- 2. List full details of all hotels in London.
- 3. List the names and addresses of all guests living in London, alphabetically ordered by name.
- 4. List all double or family rooms with a price below £40.00 per night, in ascending order of price.
- 5. How many hotels are there?
- 6. What is the average price of a room?
- 7. What is the total revenue per night from all double rooms?
- 8. List the number of rooms in each hotel.
- 9. What is the average number of bookings for each hotel in August?
- 10. What is the lost income from unoccupied rooms at each hotel today?
