Download Java. Scroll down and select your OS and then select the installer for your OS/architecture. For example, on Windows, select the link for the **x64 Installer**. For Mac, select either the x64 or Arm 64, depending on the CPU your system uses. Linux uses different package types, select either the x64 or Arm 64, depending on the CPU your system uses, and there is a sub-category for the package type your OS uses (such as Debian for Ubuntu, or RPM for Fedora).

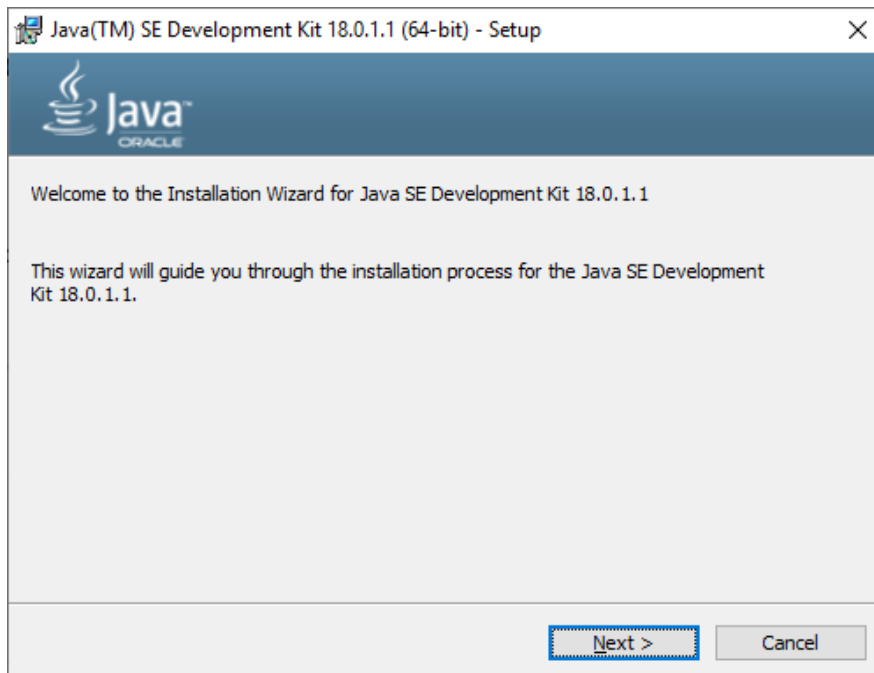

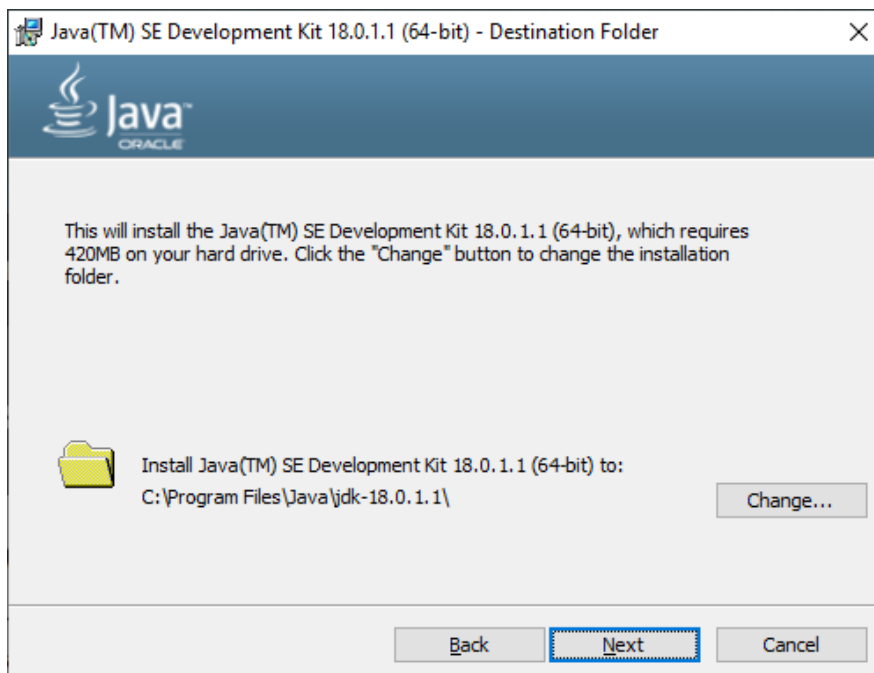

Press **Next**.

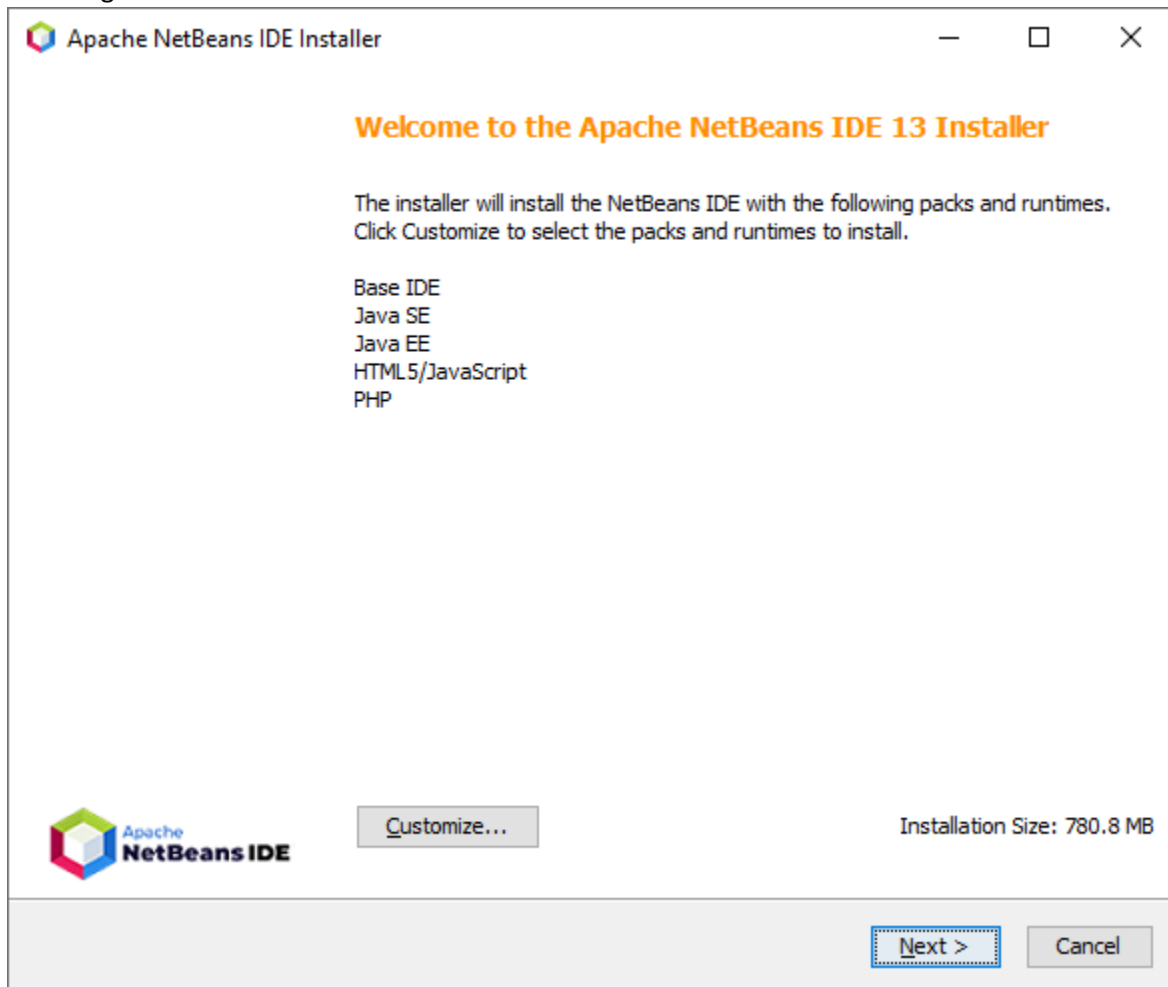


Take the defaults and press **Next**.

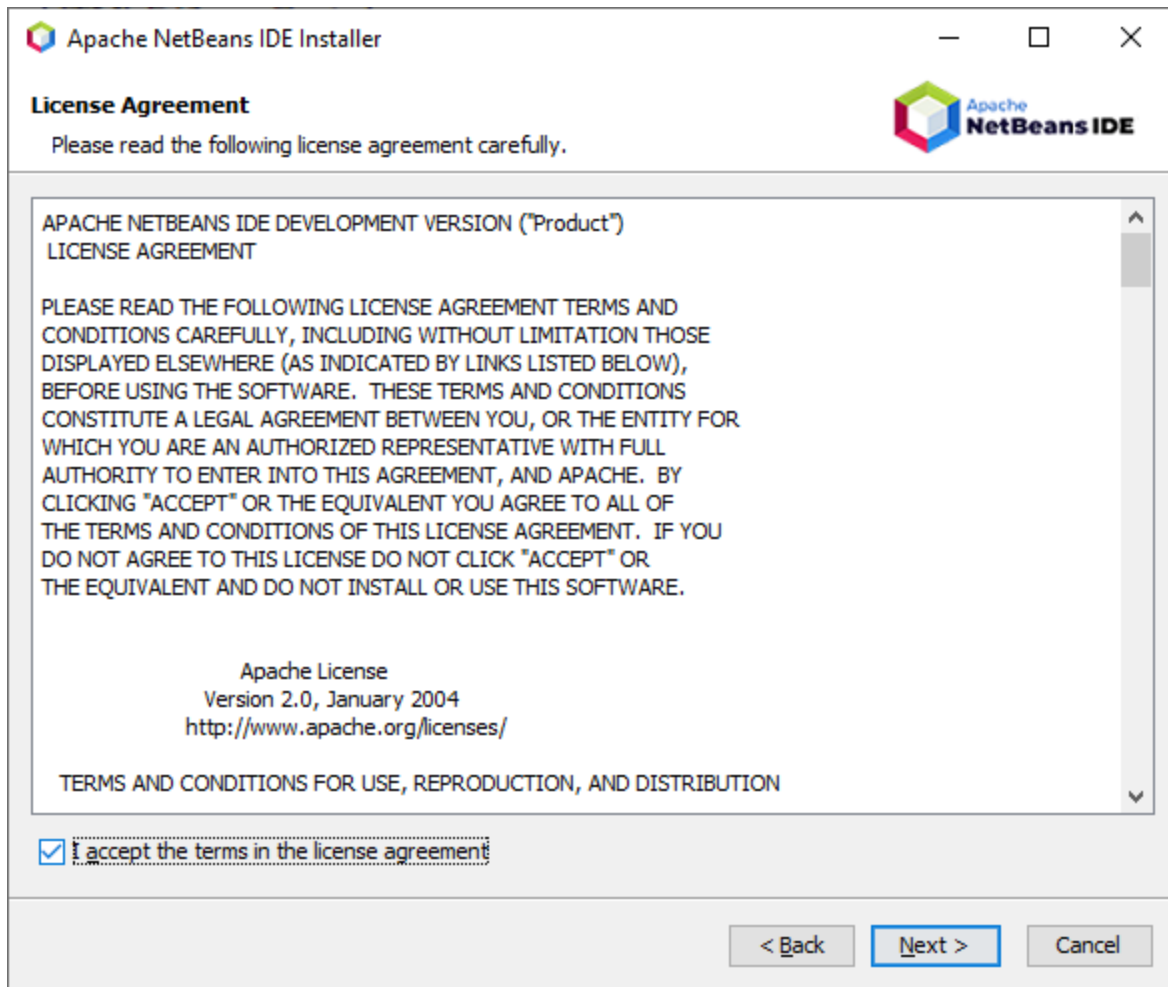


Press **Close**.

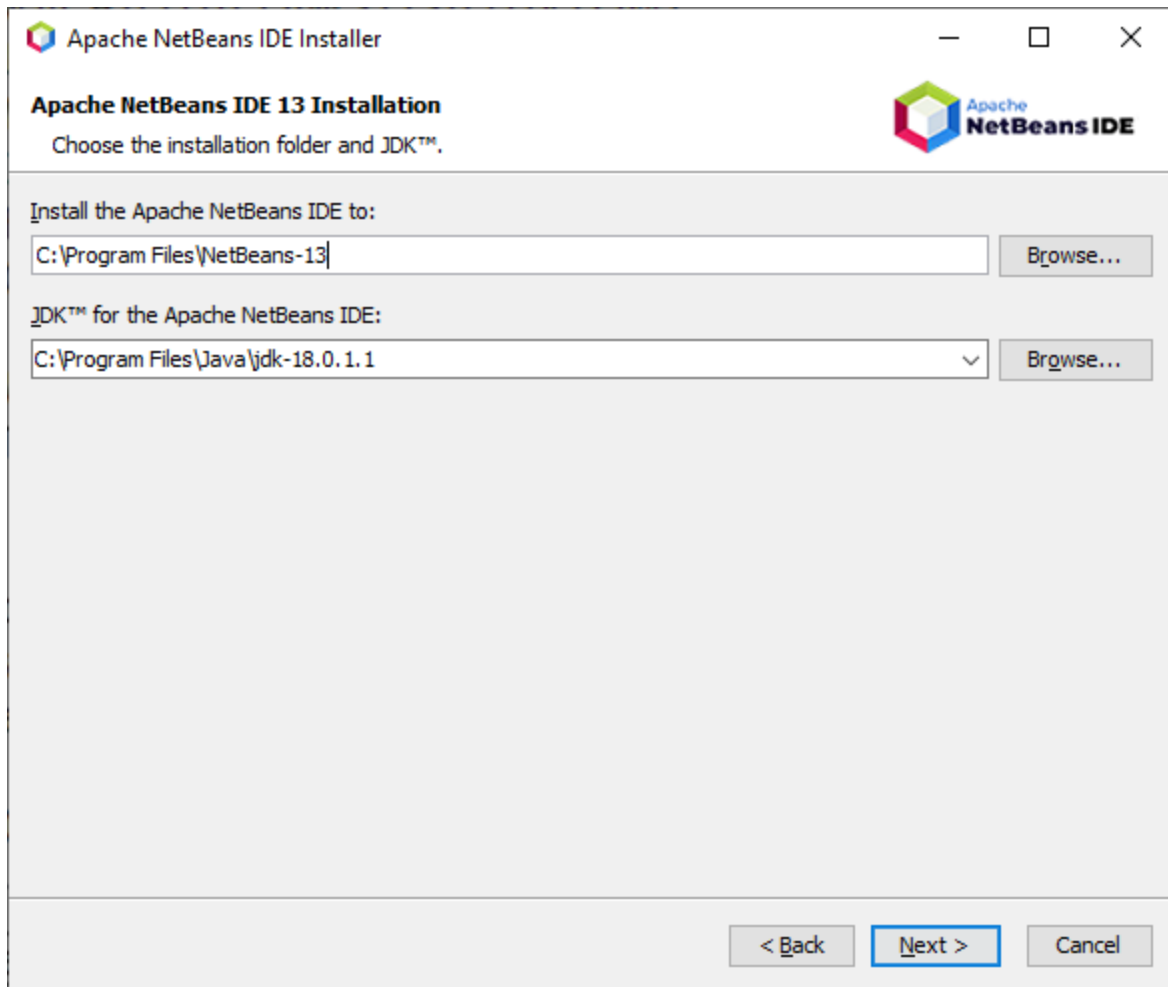
Installing Netbeans



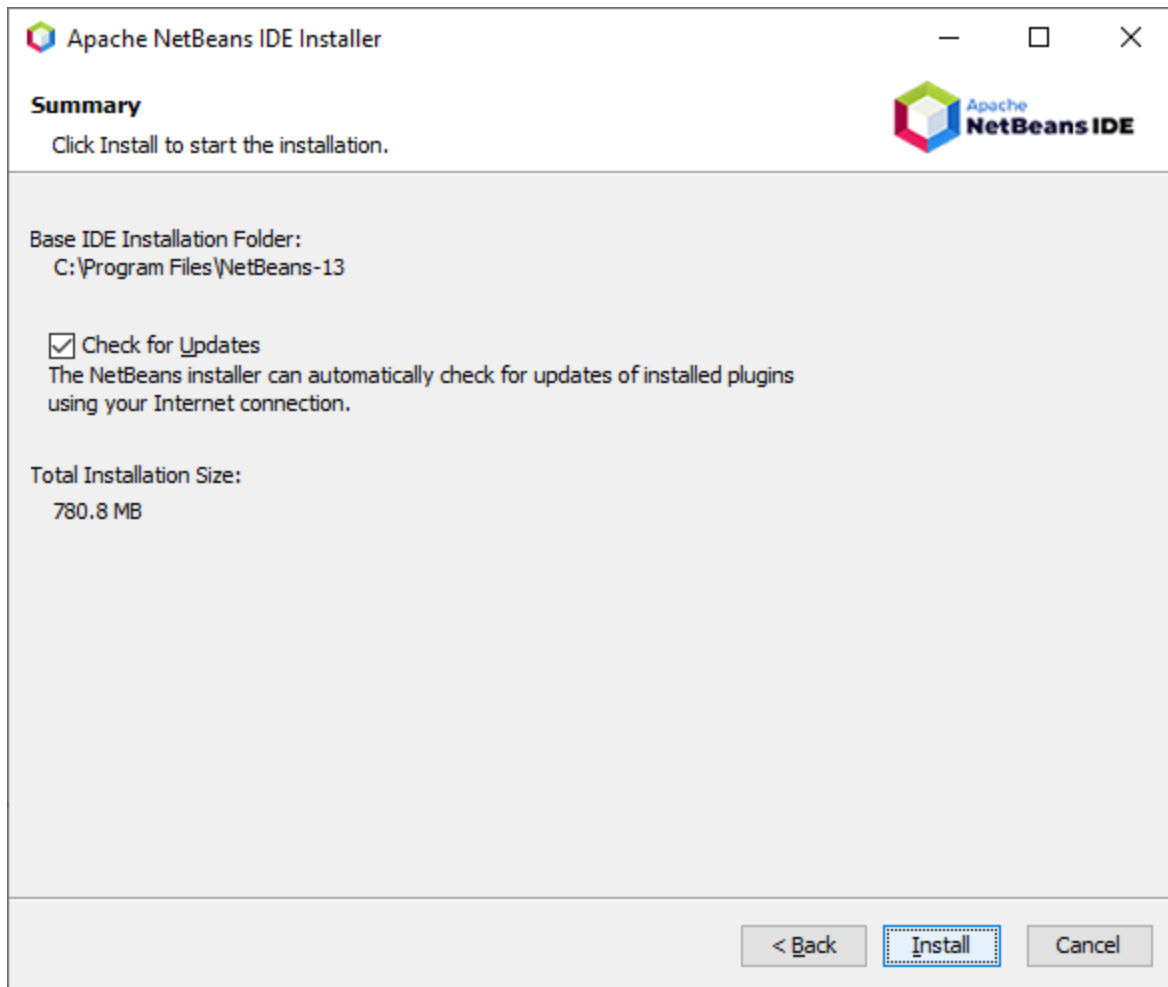
Leave the default settings. Select **Next**.



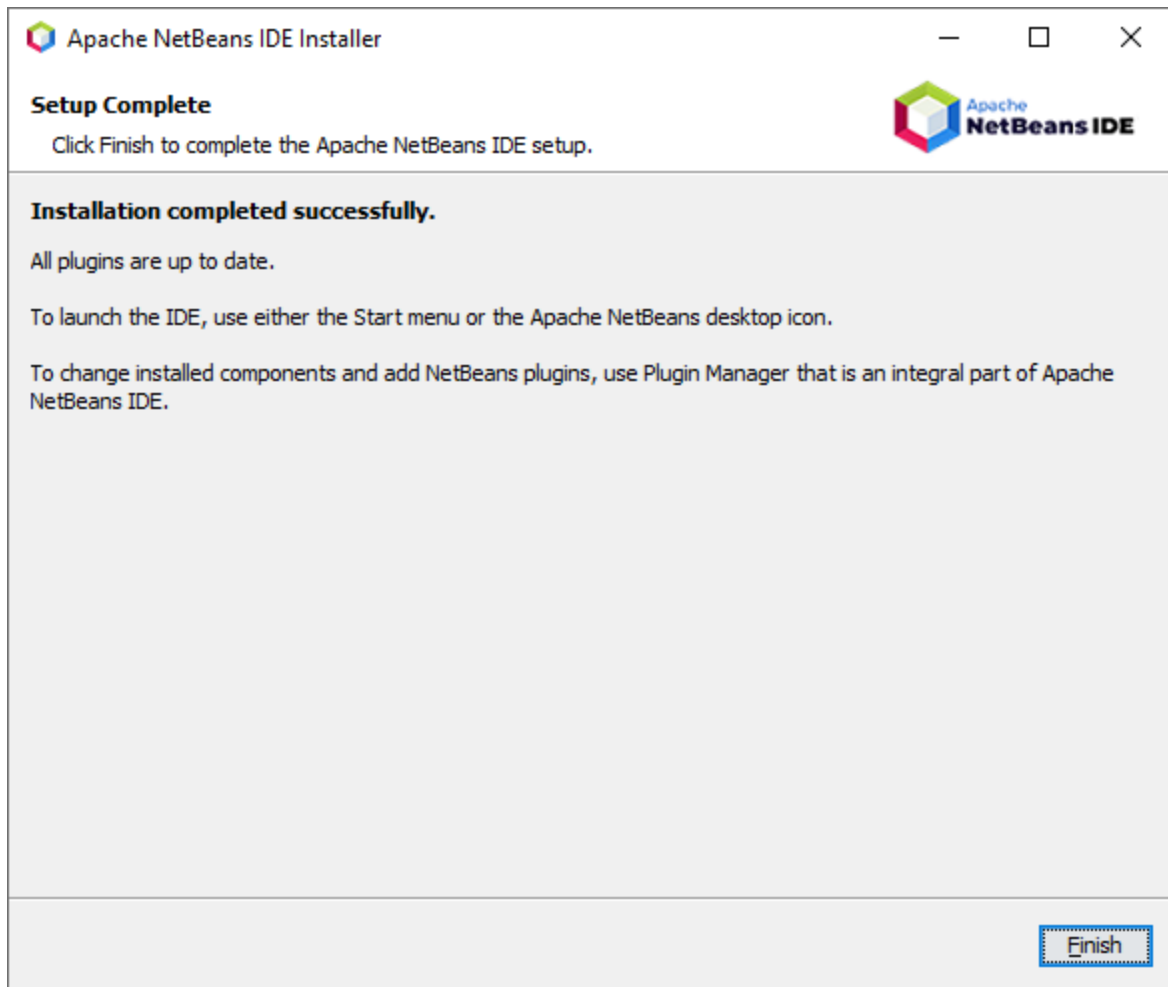
Accept the terms of the license agreement and then press **Next**.



Accept the defaults and press **Next**.

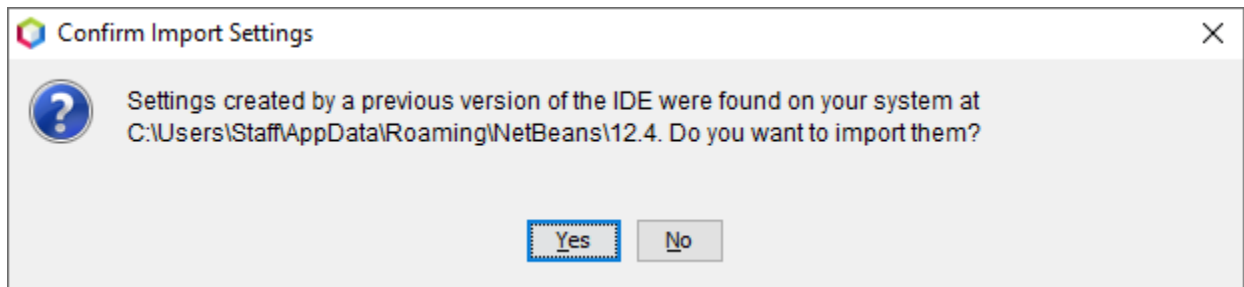


Leave the box checked the Check for Updates and press **Install**.

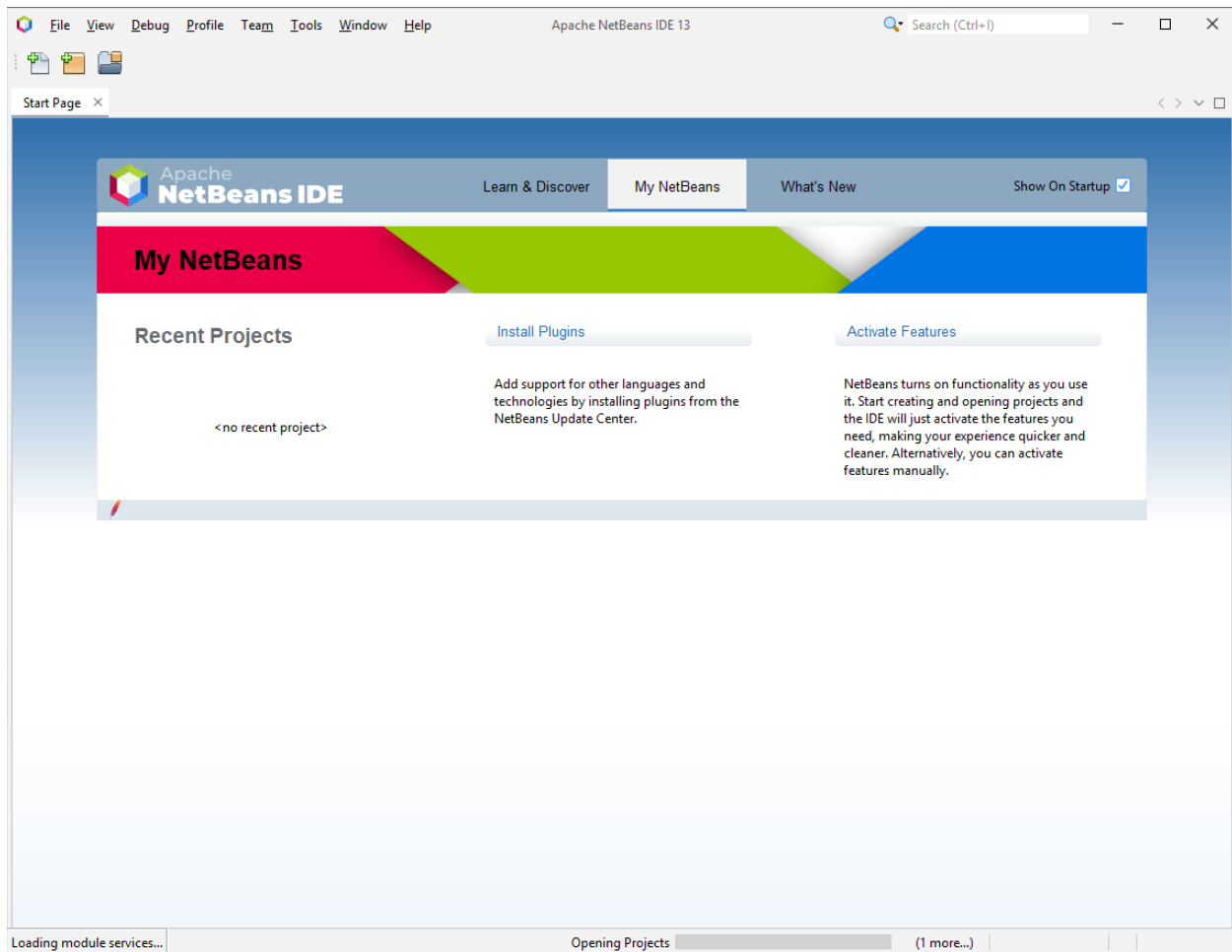


When it's done, press **Finish**.

When running Netbeans for the 1st time, if you had a previous version, it will ask to import the settings.



You can import the settings, if you previously made changes and want them in the current version.
